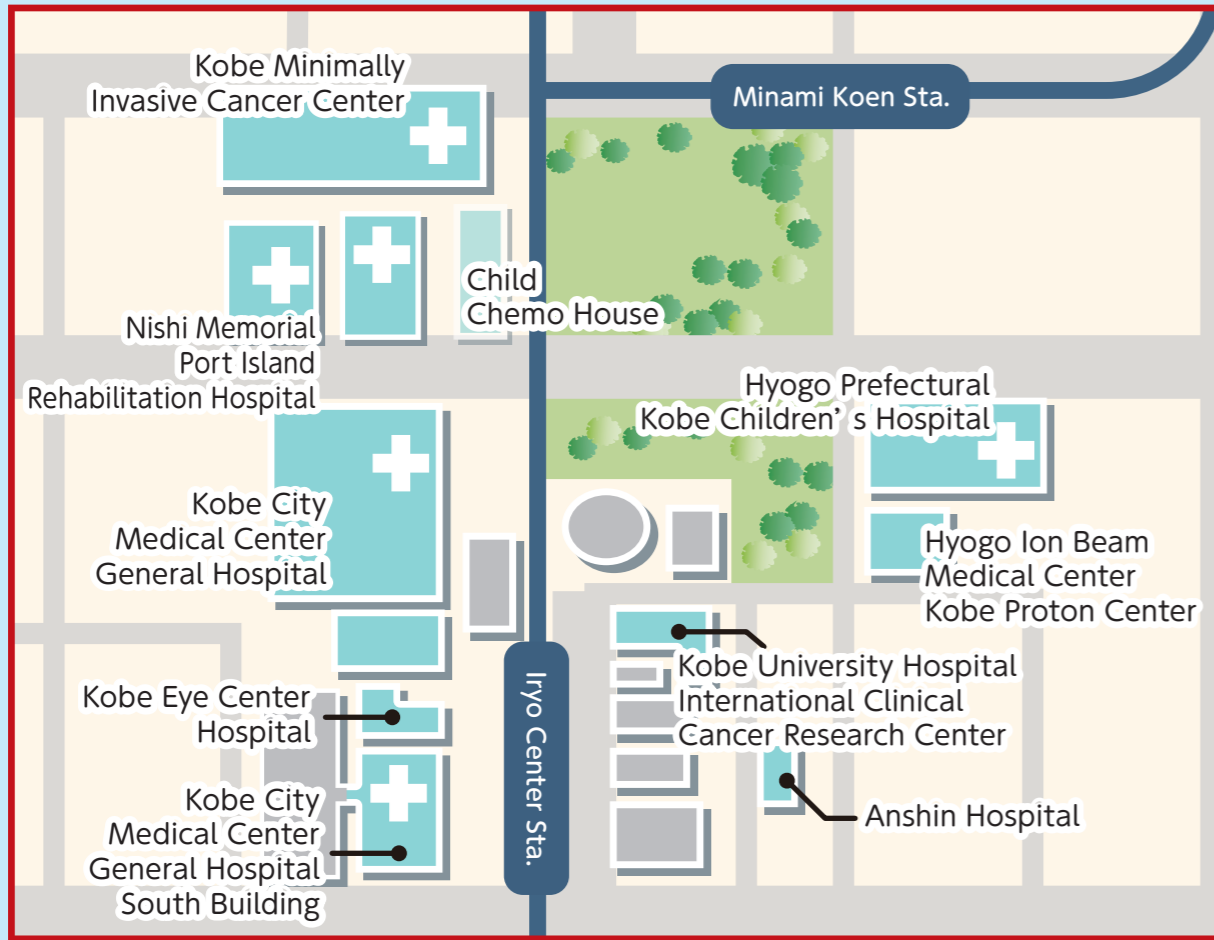
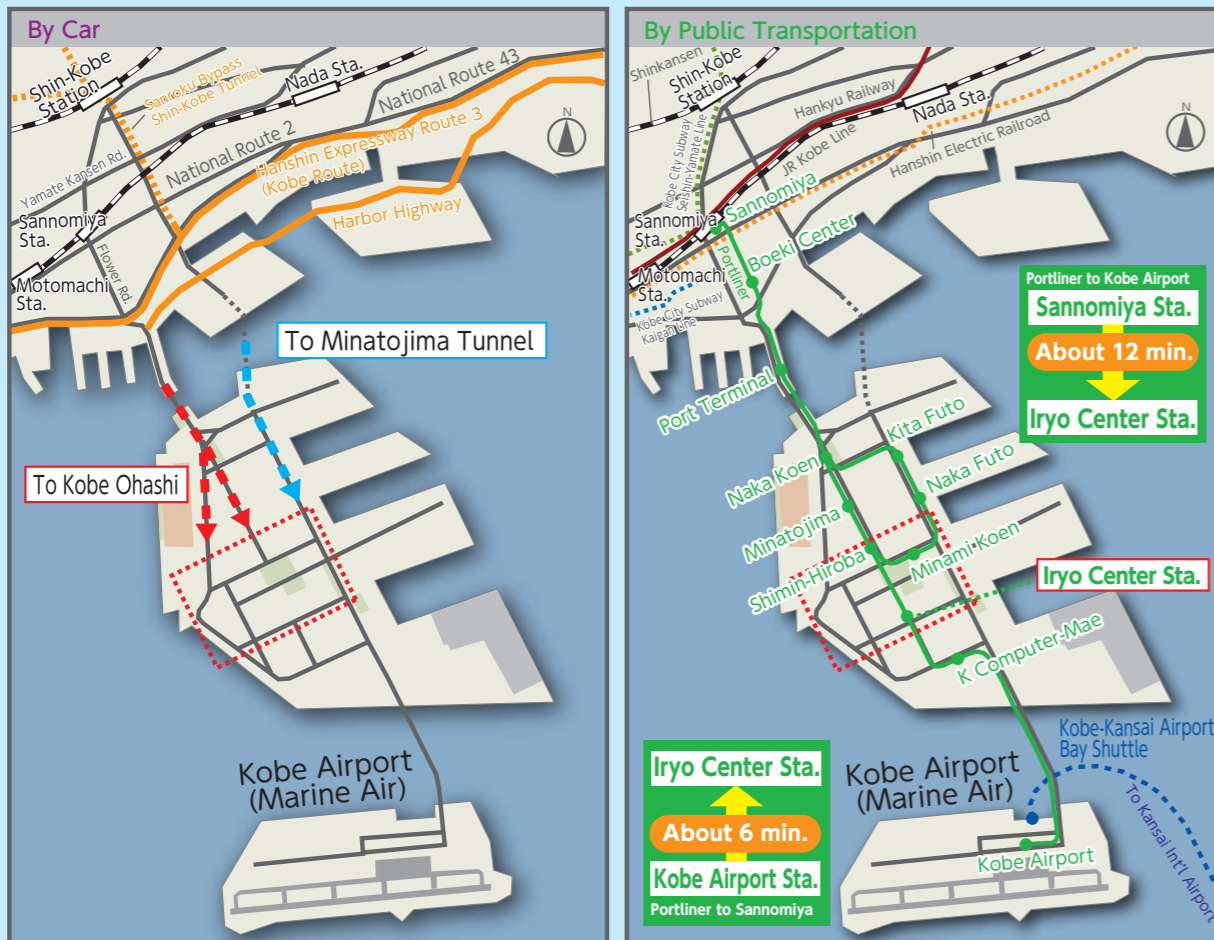

Furthermore, in cooperation with various nearby hospitals, the facility also offers advanced proton beam treatment to adult cancer patients.
